Our **3-year BSc Nursing programme** enables the student to obtain professional qualifications in accordance with European Union requirements in medical sciences and nursing practice.

The curriculum is based on strict standards and includes theoretical and practical aspects of nursing as well as general-development humanistic knowledge. During the programme the student will acquire the knowledge of basic medical subjects, such as: anatomy, biochemistry, physiology, pathology etc.; social sciences, for instance: sociology, law, pedagogy, etc. as well as General and Specialized nursing subjects. Upon graduation from Nursing programme, students can apply for a license and in turn practice nursing independently all over the world.

PLACEMENT

The purpose of the programme is to educate and prepare the graduates to perform their work with a high level of professionalism and to apply their knowledge of general, basic and specialized subjects while working. Candidates will practice in well-equipped labs where they will learn about rehabilitation and nursing procedures, health

promotion, preventive health care and health education. The skills are then transferred to real-life situations during work placements where students have the opportunity to use their broad scope knowledge of treatments in various healthcare institutions.
