Students

Long-term student departures (SMS):

countries belonging to a given group	Monthly rate for projects accepted in the 2022 competition
<u>Group 1</u> - Denmark, Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden and countries from Region 14 ²	550 €

Long-term student internships (SMT) - according to the "program guide", the monthly SMT rate must be € 150 higher than the rate assigned for study trips (SMS):

<u>Group 2</u> - Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, France, Greece, Spain, Malta, Netherlands, Germany Portugal, Italy and Region 13	700 €
<u>Group 3</u> - Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Republic of North Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Turkey	600 €

Persons (students and graduates) who will meet the criteria included in the definition of "people with fewer opportunities" (*students and graduates with fewer opportunities*) will receive an additional amount **250 €** for each month of stay, regardless of the type of departure.

The definition of " people with fewer opportunities " includes:

group of people	criteria on the basis of which the university will qualify
people with disabilities	Disability-degree certificate
people from poorer backgrounds	The decision of the university to award a social scholarship or group students who meet the criteria set out in the rector's order. For graduates-decisions made in the last year of study will be taken into account
Other groups of people defined by the University	Defined by the beneficiary in the university rules for projects KA131-2022

Short-term trips of students and graduates (stays from 5 to 30 days) to EU countries and countries third parties associated with the EU - this also applies to mixed mobility (*blended mobility*):

stay from 5 to 14 days	70 € / day	100 € / departure
stay from 15 to 30 days	50 € / day	150 € / departure

Long-term leaves of students and graduates to third countries not accompanied by Erasmus+ under KA131-2022, except for countries in regions 13 and 14

amount of monthly stipend-trips to study / internship	700 €/month
additional amount for a participant meeting the definition of "people with fewer opportunities"	250 €/month

Travel expenses they only concern:

Green travel³

In case of meeting the travel conditions defined as "green travel", students and graduates are entitled to receive individual support for the cost of living during the trip - up to a maximum of 4 additional days.

Students and graduates not receiving the standard lump sum for travel expenses are eligible to receive € 50 for meeting the travel conditions referred to as "green travel".
